- Row 7: (7,4) 15 (left), (7,5) 15 (down), (7,6) 15 (down)
- Row 8: (8,3) 5 (left), (8,5) 11 (right), (8,8) 11 (down)
- Row 9: (9,3) 11 (down), (9,4) 11 (right), (9,6) 7 (right)
